The Ride Committee will be meeting next month to plan our 2026. I compiled the survey results and we will schedule accordingly. Please send me 'retro' ideas for destinations.

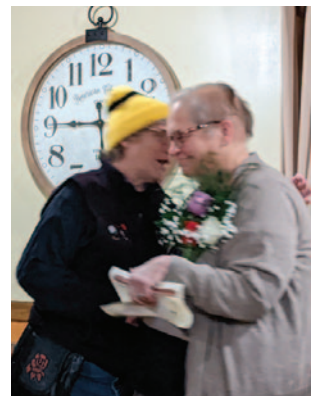

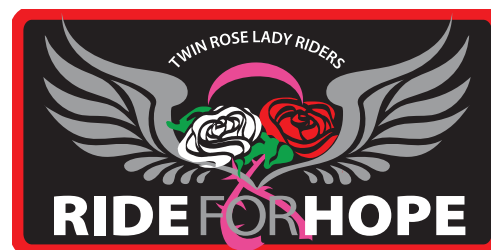
